JOB PURPOSE:

He/She is responsible for maintaining, repairs and installations of plumbing, electrical, related fixtures and components.

PRINCIPLE ACCOUNTABILITIES

- Inspects, repairs, or replaces pumps, valves and boiler systems
- Repairs piping of various size and type.
- Services and maintains air compressors.
- Inspects and tests fire sprinkler system and booster pumps; prepares documentation for compliance.
- Monitors and adjusts building automation systems.
- Monitors work done by outside contractors for adherence to Plumbing Code Requirements and reports back to supervisor.
- Assists in the writing of specifications for repairs and new construction.
- Maintains appropriate service and repair records.
- Researches, purchases and maintains inventories of equipment parts, chemicals and supplies.
- Responds to routine and emergency calls for repairs and service.
- May train and direct the work of other classified staff in the area.
- Assists and serves as back up to other Facilities employees.
- Minor electrical works.
- Checks safety equipment and replaces all components.

EMPLOYMENT STANDARDS

ABILITY TO:

- Operate and use required tools and equipment skillfully and safely.
- Perform heavy physical labor.
- Read and comprehend plans and blueprints.
- Install, maintain and repair broad range of plumbing fixtures and components, pumps, valves, boiler systems, compressors, alarm systems, and chemical treatment systems.
- Read and comprehend plans and blueprints as appropriate to trade.

- Analyze and respond safely and appropriately to emergency situations.
- Train and direct the work of other classified staff in the area.
- Follow and give oral and written instructions.
- Maintain cooperative working relationships.
- Demonstrate sensitivity to, and respect for a diverse population.

KNOWLEDGE OF:

- Thorough knowledge of the methods, materials, tools, and equipment used in the plumbing trade.
- Applicable state health and safety code requirements.
- Methods and practices followed in the maintenance of tools, machinery, and equipment.
- Safety precautions to be observed in the maintenance and installation of electronic and mechanical equipment.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Candidates/incumbents must meet the minimum qualifications as detailed below, **or file for equivalency.**
- Graduation from high school, supplemented by completion of a Union, private (in-house), military, or trade school apprenticeship program that includes theory and on-the-job work.
- At least two years as a junior-level plumber & fitter in a commercial, industrial, or facilities operations setting, or an institution of similar standing as IPSTC.
